New classes are coming to BAA Design Center!

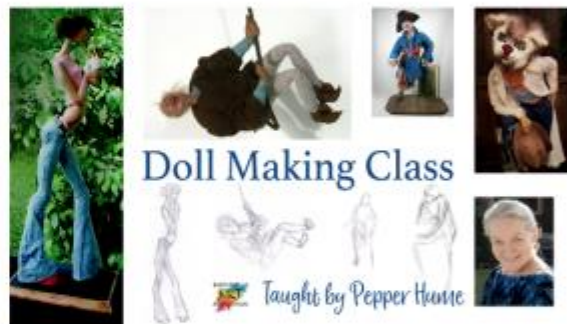
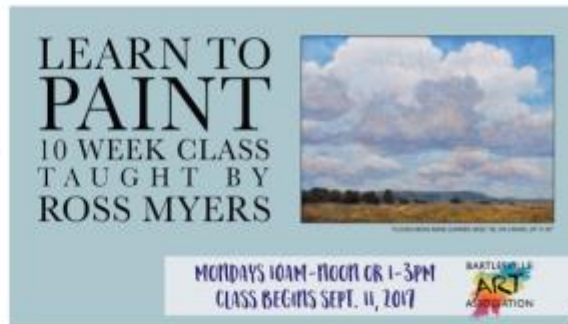
