NEW CLASSES at the BAA Design Center!

Copper Repoussé – Instructor Steven Graham is a long time Bartlesville resident, art teacher at Kane Elementary, and Director of BAA Student Art Camp. **Copper Repoussé is a technique where** a thin sheet of malleable metal is pressed and shaped to create a design in low relief. Very detailed art can be made this way. Adults and students (age 12 and older) will learn to do a portrait in profile or a figure from ancient Egyptian art. This class will meet Friday July 7 from 6-9 p.m. Cost is \$15 and supplies are included.

Figure and Gesture Drawing / Doll Making – Instructor Pepper Hume, who graduated from Col-Hi as Ardith Webber, has worked professionally for theaters in New York and Chicago as a costume and scenery designer and taught at ten universities. Pepper will begin teaching on Monday evenings from 6-8 p.m. Starts July 31. Cost is \$10 per session. Students may be high school age as well as adults.

Paper Making – Instructor Reita Adams, is a long time Bartlesville resident who is retired from a career in Art Education. This is a fun and easy class is for high school age and older. Attendees will pull several sheets each and work on embellishments for the first two sessions. During the third session Reita will teach bookbinding skills to use with the handmade papers. Class dates are Tuesday August 22, Thursday August 24, and Tuesday August 29. Class will meet in the evenings from 6-7:30 p.m. and cost is \$15 (includes supplies).

Drawing 101 – instructor Dedra Morgan is a retired elementary teacher and past president of BAA. This is a great choice for beginning artists and is for students ages 10 and older and adults. This class is full so potential class members will be put on a waiting list.
