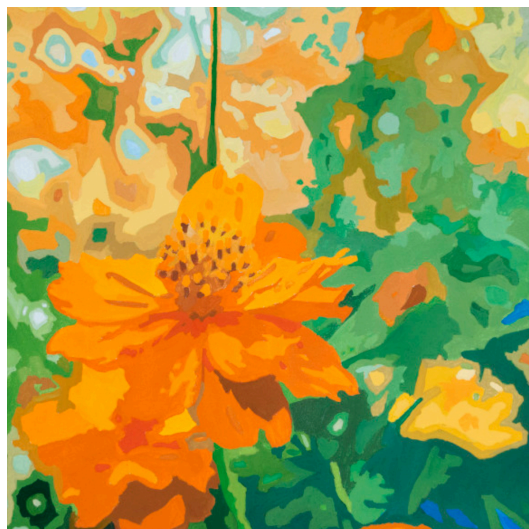


## Save the dates! 2025Masters Series

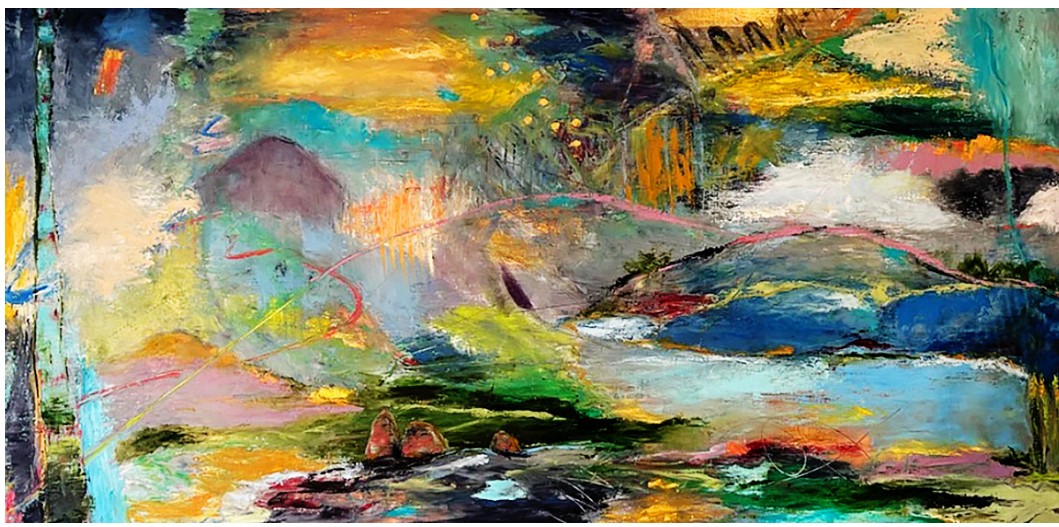
