The streets of downtown Bartlesville will be transformed into an exciting arts district on April 4th during the Bartlesville Art Association's third annual ArtWalk the 'Ville. And if last year's event was any indication, this one will be a showstopper. Featuring pop-up galleries in 12 locations with over 30 artists, view exhibiting a diverse range of media, from paintings and pottery to mixed media, glassblowing, and photography.

It is a downtown-wide celebration of creativity, community, and just the right amount of controlled chaos.

New to this year's ArtWalk is Josh Waddell of 3 Bulls Upcycling. Wadell has established a studio at The Creamery. Joining him are Andy Dossett, a photographer and Steven Graham the director of BAA's Summer Art Camp. Don't miss this new location on the ArtWalk. Wadell is a nationally recognized assemblage artist; Andy Dossett was the BAA's 2024 Best of Show winner with his photograph. Then head on down the street to see Jon Lindbloom at the Eatery. Next is Roots and Blooms at Bambino's hosting Tracey Watkins, Ivan Winger and glass artist, Erich Minton.

and Crossing 2nd. Then don't miss a quick tour of the Bartlesville Civic Ballet and experience one of their rehearsals. And, Theater Bartlesville will offer a peek into what they have to offer in 2025.Bartlesville Ballet will have performances for everyone to enjoy.
